Depart/Return to US Dates*: June 26-July 23, 2026 **Cost**: \$2,500** + airfare (estimated \$800-\$1,200)***

Ages: 15-18

Delegates arrive in San José for orientation, which includes sightseeing and cultural activities. Afterwards, they meet their Costa Rican host families and begin their homestay experience. They also come together for a mid-program excursion to a national park.
