### **8 WEEK HOMESTAY PROGAM**

Depart/Return to US Dates\*: June 11—August 6, 2026

**Cost:** \$5,500\*\* + airfare (estimated \$2,000-\$2,400)\*\*\*

**Ages: 15-18** 

For the first 4 weeks, stay with a host family in the Tokyo area, while attending an intensive Japanese language program. This program is for youth that are interested in a Japanese classroom experience! In the second 4 weeks, you will be placed with a new host family outside of Tokyo with a host sibling of similar age. Japanese language knowledge recommended (but not required).
