4 WEEK HOMESTAY PROGAM

Depart/Return to US Dates*: July 16-August 13, 2026 **Cost:** \$3,200** + airfare (estimated \$1,600-\$2,000)***

Ages: 12-18

Delegates arrive in Seoul for a one-night arrival orientation led by Korea 4-H, which includes an introduction to Korean culture and basic language phrases. Afterwards, delegates meet their Korea 4-H host family and begin their homestay. Delegates may have 2 different host families during the program. The program concludes with sightseeing in Seoul.

- **Program cost does NOT include airfare. Airfare estimate is for international airfare. Participant is responsible for purchasing domestic airfare to/from US gateway city. For South Korea, the gateway city is Seattle, WA.
- ***Airfare estimates are based on ticket prices from the past few years plus the potential for increased prices in 2026.
